Help shape the future of North Eveleigh

The creation of a new neighbourhood in North Eveleigh, next to Carriageworks, will be the first stage of the transformation of the Central to Eveleigh rail corridor. We want your help to create a new park and guide the restoration of the Clothing Store for community uses to create the heart of the future North Eveleigh neighbourhood.

North Eveleigh will showcase how the vision and planning principles, developed with the community for the whole area, can be applied to a local neighbourhood through a combination of new buildings, parks, community facilities, public art and heritage interpretation.

To achieve this, the current concept plan for North Eveleigh, approved in 2008 for 700 to 750 new homes, is being reviewed. Following the upcoming consultation we will exhibit a revised development proposal in 2016.

North Eveleigh key features

We are proposing:

- a bigger park than previously proposed, plus several small pocket parks
- approximately 710 new apartments, in addition to the 88 affordable housing apartments already on site
- around 500 basement car parking spaces
- commercial space, to include provision for a café and childcare facilities
- heritage interpretation and public art
- pedestrian and bike connections
- restoration and use of the Clothing Store for the community
- the potential for a possible future crossing over the rail corridor.

Restoration and use of the Clothing Store with a new park by its side is part of our shared vision to celebrate the area's rich diversity and heritage and to give everyone access to community facilities.

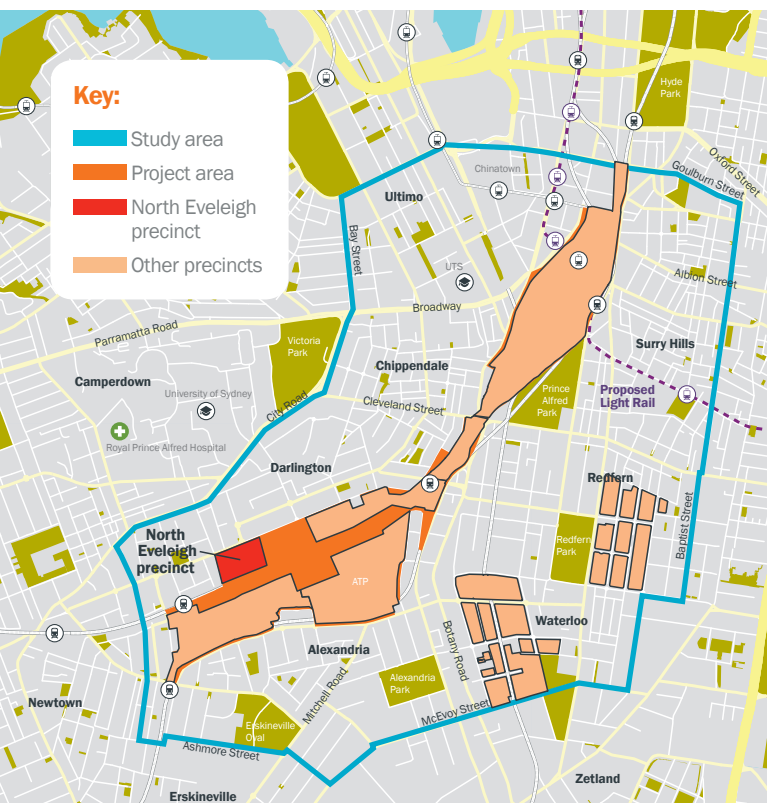
The Central to Eveleigh Program

The Central to Eveleigh Transformation and Transport Program covers mainly government owned land in and around the rail corridor from Central to Macdonaldtown and Erskineville Stations. It also considers the Waterloo and Redfern estates.

We are proposing housing and employment opportunities together with new shops, parks, playgrounds, childcare, community facilities, student and affordable housing and opportunities for new connections across the rail corridor.

Local residents have told us they love the diversity, creativity and friendliness of the area and how close it is to the city. We want to build on these great strengths and invite you to shape the future of your community.

The focus now is on getting the detail right in readiness for the public exhibition of the urban transformation strategy in 2016. The strategy will progressively guide change in the area, with key moves including the renewal of Redfern Station and delivery of a mix of housing for all types of people.
